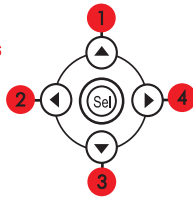




Display Control Keys

- 1: speed dial
- 2: received calls
- 3: missed calls
- 4: placed calls



Placing a Call

using the handset:
Pick up phone and dial number, or dial number, then pick up phone.

using speakerphone:
1: With handset on-hook, press:
- any assigned line key, or
- button, or
- **NewCall** soft key
2: Dial the number.

using the optional headset
With the headset connected, do one of the following:
1: Press the **NewCall** soft key then press .
Dial the desired number
2: Dial the number then press .

Answering A Call

using the handset:
Pick up the handset.
using speakerphone:
With the handset on-hook, press:
- button, or
- the line key, or
- **Answer** soft key
using the optional headset:
Press .

Call Transfer

- 1: During a call, press **Transfer** or the **Transfer** soft key (the active call is placed on hold).
- 2: If a blind transfer is required, press the **Blind** soft key.
- 3: Call the number to which you want to transfer the call or access the number from a call list, and press the **Dial** soft key.
- 4: After the ring-back sound is heard, or after the party answers, press **Transfer** to complete the transfer.

Call Hold & Resume

During a call, press **Hold** or the **Hold** soft key. Press **Hold** again or the **Resume** soft key to retrieve the call.

If multiple calls are on hold on a single line, use the **Up** or **Down** keys to select the desired call, then press the **Resume** soft key to return to this call.

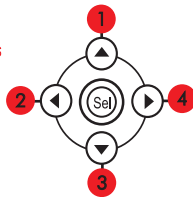
If calls are on hold on more than one line, the call details can be viewed by pressing & holding the desired line key. If a line key is pressed briefly, the first call on hold on that line will be retrieved.

During a call, users can alternate between handset, headset or handsfree modes by pressing the **Headset** or **Handset** keys, or picking up the handset



Display Control Keys

Placing a Call

using the handset:
Pick up phone and dial number, or dial number, then pick up phone.

using speakerphone:
1: With handset on-hook, press:

Answering A Call

using the handset:

Call Transfer

- 1: During a call, press **Transfer** or the **Transfer** soft key (the active call is placed on hold).
- 2: If a blind transfer is required, press the **Blind** soft key.
- 3: Call the number to which you want to transfer the call or access the number from a call list, and press the **Dial** soft key.
- 4: After the ring-back sound is heard, or after the party answers, press **Transfer** to complete the transfer.

Call Hold & Resume

During a call, press **Hold** or the **Hold** soft key. Press **Hold** again or the **Resume** soft key to retrieve the call.

If multiple calls are on hold on a single line, use the **Up** or **Down** keys to select the desired call, then press the **Resume** soft key to return to this call.

If calls are on hold on more than one line, the call details can be viewed by pressing & holding the desired line key. If a line key is pressed briefly, the first call on hold on that line will be retrieved.

During a call, users can alternate between handset, headset or handsfree modes by pressing the **Headset** or **Handset** keys, or picking up the handset

3-Way Conference Calls

creating a three-way conference call:

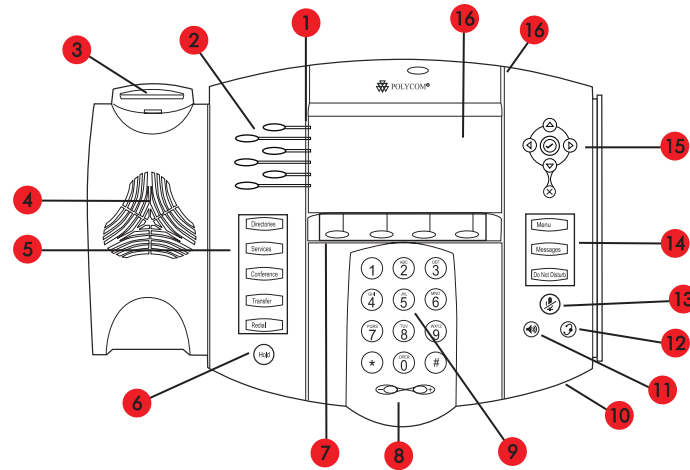
- 1: Call the first party.
- 2: Press **Conference** or the **Confmc** soft key to create a new call (the active call is placed on hold).
- 3: Call the second party.
- 4: When the second party answers, press **Conference** or the **Confmc** soft key again to join all parties in the conference.
- 5: When a conference has been established, press the **Split** soft key to split the conference into two calls on hold.

Voice Mail

Message Waiting Indicator LED & individual line LED indicators on the phone will flash. A stutter dial tone will replace the normal dial tone to indicate that message(s) are waiting at the message center.

listen to voice messages:

- 1: Press **Messages** to access voice messaging
- 2: Follow voice prompts to listen to messages.

3-Way Conference Calls

creating a three-way conference call:

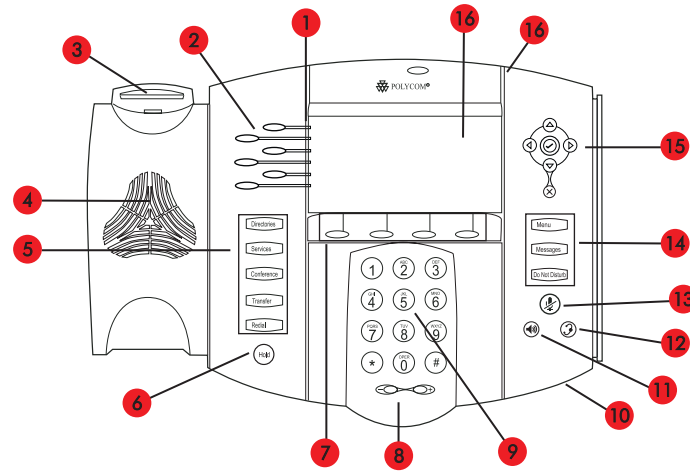
- 1: Call the first party.
- 2: Press **Conference** or the **Confmc** soft key to create a new call (the active call is placed on hold).
- 3: Call the second party.
- 4: When the second party answers, press **Conference** or the **Confmc** soft key again to join all parties in the conference.
- 5: When a conference has been established, press the **Split** soft key to split the conference into two calls on hold.

Voice Mail

Message Waiting Indicator LED & individual line LED indicators on the phone will flash. A stutter dial tone will replace the normal dial tone to indicate that message(s) are waiting at the message center.

listen to voice messages:

- 1: Press **Messages** to access voice messaging
- 2: Follow voice prompts to listen to messages.
